

## Basic Assembly/Disassembly Photos



**Assembly:** Lay cords into place.  
Simple snap together of cap to base.



**Disassembly:** Slide cap from end,  
twist and peel away from base.



**Interlocking runs assembly:** Typical  
butt joint of base with 6" end cap



6" base end filler at end of multiple



6" cap end filler at end of multiple run

**Cleaning:** Chordsavers can be wiped down with simple soap and water. Do not clean with solvent based cleaners.

**Warning:** ChordSavers are not to be used with bare wires. Although they are intended to protect cables & cords, and assist in keep them from sliding on a surface, they are not intended as intentional steps. ChordSavers are water resistant, but not water proof.
